Personal Challenge – This week's challenge is to start and end your day with praise. Begin your morning and evening prayer times by asking the Holy Spirit to bring 4 blessings to mind. Then spend time thanking and praising God for each of those blessings.

How does beginning with praise affect your day? How does ending your day with praise impact your perspective on the events of your day?

"Family" Challenge – As we prepare our hearts for the Holy Spirit's arrival this Pentecost, let's live out Psalm 95:2, "Let us enter His presence with thanksgiving, let us shout triumphantly to Him in song". Your challenge is to make instruments, play real ones, or have your own air band and have a "family" time of praise and worship. It does not have to be long, but sing praises to God and make a joyful noise to the Lord!
