In the past I have shared about the <u>North American Network of</u> <u>Charismatic Covenant Communities</u>, an organization formed three years ago enabling Covenant Communities in North America to support one another.

The purpose of this email is threefold:

- 2. To request prayers for the upcoming NAN leadership meeting that Laurie and I are hosting next weekend. There will be 19 attendees from Communities across North America including two communities that are not yet members. During the meetings we will be praying about the message we are hearing from the Holy Spirit, discussing ways to support one another, and planning our annual February conference. Your prayer support is very much valued.
- 3. Finally, I want to make everyone aware of a new collaborative organization that was created to foster even broader cooperation across worldwide Charismatic Covenant Communities.

In July of this year representatives from four networks of Charismatic Communities met in London to discuss a <u>Strategic</u> <u>Partnership</u>. Represented were Sword of the Spirit, European Network, North American Network, and Servants of Jesus community in Australia. Leaders from these networks have been meeting over the last six years to bring about reconciliation and restore unity. The culmination of the meeting yielded agreement to formally partner and form the "International Partnership of Ecumenical, Charismatic Communities" (IPECC).

The purpose of IPECC is to provide mutual support across our respective networks. Priority is placed on hearing the Lord and supporting our respective missions. There is a mutual desire to support each other in outreach, raising up a new generation, etc. We want to learn best practices from participating in each other's conferences, visiting other communities, etc. We want to be able to share our gifts freely with one another and be a place for other like-minded networks and communities to find a home.
