They changed their name and priorities to better align with Pope Francis' creation of Charis and the priorities he gave to the Catholic Charismatic Renewal.

As you learn about these organizations you will better understand what the Holy Father is asking of the Renewal...namely:

To bring the baptism in the Holy Spirit to the whole Church,

- To build unity in the Body of Christ, and
- To serve the poor

Our Community has a long-standing tradition of bringing the baptism of the Holy Spirit to as many as possible through our Life in the Spirit seminars. We have also been active in building unity in the Body of Christ welcoming members from all faiths and supporting Matteo's ministry and many other ecumenical ministries. We have also helped many members and others through our own 'St. Vincent de Paul' effort to help those in need.

One of the reasons for me to use this letter to remind you of these efforts is that the Pentecost Today USA organization announced at the conference yesterday a **nine-year novena** to prepare for the 2000th anniversary of Pentecost that will be celebrated in 2033. The novena will start on May 19th 2024 (Pentecost 2024), and initiate nine years of specific initiatives to build momentum for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

The initiative is explained in detail in the latest issue of their publication that was passed out at the conference and will soon be posted at this link:

https://www.pentecosttodayusa.org/magazine/. The novena is divided into three parts. The first three years, part one, is a focus on the current Charismatic Renewal and building it up for evangelization. The focus of the second part, second three years, will be upon the Church passing on the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and bringing about Christian Unity. The last three years, part three, will focus on outreach to the whole world. Each year will have a more specific focus.

We do not have to wait for the formal start of the novena to start praying for this New Pentecost to come. Let us together start praying for this New Pentecost to fall upon our families, our Community, our churches, our country, and our world...and may this new outpouring of the Holy Spirit begin with me.
