Reflection

It is impossible to overstate the significance of what we celebrate today. The course of human history took a 180-degree turn. Peter said yes and proceeded to speak. Today we are encouraged to do the same. Today the Bible in a Year listeners were treated to the story of Gideon. My prayer for myself, you, and the whole of our Community is that we will have the courage of Gideon to battle the enemy with full confidence in the power of God and witness God's limitless love. That we will respond to the sacrifice of our Lord and see in His resurrection the clean slate we must, through the power of His Holy Spirit, witness to those God will lead us today.

Let us build His Kingdom, one soul at a time. Let us make this a very special Easter by proceeding to speak as Peter did.

I pledge to live for You today and every day and be a part of Your army telling the world about what You accomplished today and Your great love for every one of us.
