Reflection - As I read the first reading ([Jer 1:4-5, 17-19](#)) I could not help but think of our Community. We are a fortified city. You bless me. You protect me. We are a blessing and protection for one another. This is who we are called to be...His Delight, a people committed to our Lord and living our covenant with Him and each other day-after-day! The world, the flesh, and the devil will fight against us but our Lord will deliver us!

What more can be said of Paul's words from 1 Corinthians ([1 Cor 12:31—13:13](#)) regarding Love. Love is the basis of life. Family and Community are the proving ground as to how we are faring on the road to imitate God's unconditional love of us. My exhortation for this week is to take this passage read it each morning. Let these words permeate us each day. Ask the Holy Spirit to give us the gifts to live each day in love. Ask Him to bring those into our lives that He either wants us to repair a relationship with or create a new one. This is how He changes the world...by our Yes to Love as He loved.

Let us pray together. "Lord You called my name and asked me to make a covenant with You. I said Yes and today, I again say Yes. My request is that You help me to start every day in Your presence.
